Step-By-Step Instructions

Warning:

Safety First: Always use correct safety equipment.

This towbar is NOT to be drilled, cut, welded or modified in any way.

Check the surrounding area before drilling into chassis or body panels for fuel lines, wiring harnesses and other components that may be a hazard.

General:

Before fitting this towbar read fitting instructions and check installation hardware is correct.

Check that the towbar is suitable for the vehicle and be wary of any changes to the vehicle design that may conflict with the fitting of this towbar.

After drilling, blow any filings clear, remove any swarf and treat exposed metal with a rust inhibitor.

If this vehicle requires a bumper cut out, please check to make sure that you measure twice and check twice before cutting any panels as some bumper profiles can change.

If you are not sure then ask your towbar supplier.

Tighten all bolts as specified on the last page.

1. REMOVE ALL BOLTS FROM TOW BAR.
 - 1.1. REMOVE SHIPPING HOOK AND DISCARD.
 - 1.2. FIT 3 X BOLTS ON WIRE INTO DRIVERS SIDE SUBFRAME CORRESPONDING WITH HOLES ON TOW BAR.
 - 1.3. INSTALL TOW BAR USING 2 X M10 BOLTS AND WASHERS SUPPLIED ON PASSENGER SIDE AND NUTS AND WASHERS SUPPLIED ON DRIVERS SIDE.
2. TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS TO SPECIFIED RATINGS.
 - 2.1. FIT BALL MOUNT WITH M16 BOLTS AND WASHERS PROVIDED AND TIGHTEN.
3. ATTACH RATINGS STICKER TO DRIVERS SIDE DOOR PILLAR.
