Towbar Fitting Instructions



Step-By-Step Instructions

Warning:

Safety First: Always use correct safety equipment.

This towbar is NOT to be drilled, cut, welded or modified in any way.

Check the surrounding area before drilling into chassis or body panels for fuel lines, wiring harnesses and other components that may be a hazard.

General:

Before fitting this towbar read fitting instructions and check installation hardware is correct.

Check that the towbar is suitable for the vehicle and be wary of any changes to the vehicle design that may conflict with the fitting of this towbar.

After drilling, blow any filings clear, remove any swarf and treat exposed metal with a rust inhibitor.

If this vehicle requires a bumper cut out, please check to make sure that you measure twice and check twice before cutting any panels as some bumper profiles can change.

If you are not sure then ask your towbar supplier.

Tighten all bolts as specified on the last page.

- 1. Remove bumper.
 - 1.1. Lift Tailgate.
 - 1.2. Remove 2 bolts from behind tailgate holding bumper.
 - 1.3. Remove 4 screws from each wheel arch, 1 at the top, 1 from underneath and 2 from behind splash guard up into quarter panel.
 - 1.4. Remove plastic cover from underneath and discard.
 - 1.5. Remove 2 scrivets from bottom of bumper.
- 2. Remove crash cans.
- 3. Remove spare wheel and spare wheel cover from inside of boot.
- 4. Fit towbar to vehicle by the bottom of the chassis rail on driver's side and the inner-side of the chassis rail on the passenger side.

- 5. Fit 2x M12 bolts on wire with square plates through rear holes in chassis rail to line up with rear holes in towbar. Fit nuts & washers supplied.
- 6. Fit 2x M12 bolts on wire with square plates through holes in chassis rail to line up with forward holes in towbar. Fit nuts & washers.
- 7. Using the towbar as a guide, drill 2x 11mm holes into wheel well.
- 8. Fit 2x M10 bolts & plates through drilled holes and fit nuts & washers from underneath.
- 9. Tighten all bolts to torque listing below.
- 10. Re fit bumper.
- 11. Re fit spare wheel and cover.
- 12. Fit tongue with bolts supplied.
- 13. Fit door sticker supplied to door.
